Entry Form Information & Show Rules

1. **ENTRIES CLOSE August 24th, 2009** otherwise they will be considered late entries and charged accordingly. This rule will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED**. Horse fee only will double on late entries (per horse/per day).
2. Paint class fees: \$8.00 per class (up to 6 classes)
 \$48.00 per double combination per day (open/amateur; open/youth)
3. GMEC class fees: \$8.00 per class for non-MPHC members
 \$6.00 per class for MPHc members
4. Stakes class fees: \$15.00 per class
5. Paint classes, Stallion Service classes and Futurity classes are only open to registered American Paint Horses. For Futurity classes, the horse owner and exhibitor (if different) must be members of MPHc. Stakes classes and GMEC classes are open to all breeds.
6. All fees for entries must accompany the entry forms (no post-dated cheques). Entry forms must be signed by the exhibitor, or in the case of a youth, by the parent or guardian. **NO entry forms will be processed without a SIGNED WAIVER.**
7. Please make cheques payable to Maritime Paint Horse Club. NSF cheques will be subject to a \$30 handling fee.
8. **Insurance is MANDATORY to participate** (NBEA, NSEF, etc.) Proof of insurance **MUST** accompany the entry forms.
9. **One entry form PER HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION** is required (example: if both Johnny and Janie will be showing Patches, two entry forms are required – one for Johnny & Patches and one for Janie & Patches). Please note, there will only be one Paint processing fee, drug testing fee, and horse fee in this case.
10. Stall fees are \$55.00 for the weekend (there is no daily rate). To reserve stalls please contact Jodi Smith at 506-387-8227. Stalls are limited and **MUST** be paid for via the entry form.
11. Bedding will NOT be provided in bulk this year. Bedding can be purchased on site at the market price. Bedding will be available for purchase Friday, September 4th from 6:00pm to 9:00pm and each morning from 6:00am to 7:00am. Exhibitors are permitted to bring their own bedding (no straw).
12. Hay and feed will **NOT** be available for sale on the show grounds.

14. The show office will be open Friday from 6pm to 9pm and Saturday from 6am to 7am. **THE SHOW OFFICE WILL NOT BE OPEN AT ANY OTHER TIME TO ENTER FOR THIS SHOW, PLEASE HAVE YOUR FORMS FILLED OUT PROPERLY BEFORE ENTERING THE SHOW OFFICE.**
15. Post entries will be accepted the day of the show but the show secretary must be notified a minimum of 3 classes prior to a horse entering the ring for a class that is not on the original entry form. This rule will be strictly enforced as we are on a tight time schedule. Post entries will be charged an **additional \$3.00** per class.
16. Any questions or concerns may be directed to the show manager, Samantha Legere. She will be on-site for the duration of the weekend.
17. Ponies may only show in the pony classes and command classes.

MARITIME PAINT HORSE CLUB SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

1. This show is APHA approved and will follow the rules of the Official APHA Rule Book for the Paint pointed classes. GMEC classes will also follow the rules in the APHA Rule Book. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to know the rules.
2. The GMEC classes will be pointed for GMEC circuit year end awards.
3. Horses must be registered with the APHA to show in the Paint pointed classes. A photocopy of the registration papers **MUST** accompany the entry form or the entry will not be processed for the Paint pointed classes.
4. Horses must be entered in the name of the recorded owner.
5. A youth/junior exhibitor is **18 years of age or younger as at January 1, 2009**. Date of birth must appear on the entry form. Birth certificate or sworn statement may be required. Youth APHA exhibitors **MUST** have a valid youth card from the APHA. A photocopy of the youth card **MUST** accompany the entry form.
6. Paint amateur exhibitors **MUST** have a valid amateur card from the APHA. A photocopy of the amateur card **MUST** accompany the entry form.
7. For Paint classes, a “junior” or “senior” classification is on the horse. For GMEC classes, a “junior” or “senior” classification is on the rider/handler.
8. No stallions are permitted to compete in youth classes. Stallions may only be shown by a senior exhibitor except for APHA open classes in which case the exhibitor must be at least 16 years of age.
9. Fees paid will be forfeited unless a written veterinarian’s certificate can be presented on the day of the show, in which case 75% of the entry forms will be returned.
10. THE MPHC recommends that you have your horse vaccinated
11. Ribbons will be awarded to the first six placings in each Paint class.
12. Ribbons & payouts for GMEC classes and Stakes classes are as follows:

13. **JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL**. The judge on Sunday will break any ties for the overall high point awards.
14. The show committee reserves the right to combine any classes with less than three exhibitors. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry to this show.
15. Any act deemed as abusive towards an animal or individual is strictly prohibited and shall mean immediate expulsion from the show and show grounds, forfeiting all fees paid.
16. There will be a 5 second penalty for a knocked over obstacle in the games classes (poles, barrels, etc.)
17. For insurance purposes, all horses must have a stall (no tying to trailers allowed).

18. The attached Barn Rules issued by Princess Louise Park Show Center Inc. **MUST** be followed.
19. Proper attire should be worn in all classes. Exhibitor's numbers must be worn and visible at all times.
20. Exhibitors are responsible to **BE READY WHEN THE CLASS IS CALLED**.
21. No one person may compete or be issued a ring number before signatures on the waiver forms is obtained.
22. The sponsors, organizing committee and show staff do not assume any responsibility for accidents or illness to horses, attendants, riders, spectators, or any other person on the property or for the loss of, or damage to, any equipment or personal belongings while attending the show
23. **MPHC members** can qualify for the following year end awards (***NOTE: BOTH the horse owner and the exhibitor (if different) MUST be members of MPHC to qualify for these awards:***)
- High Point & Reserve High Point Amateur (includes all Paint amateur classes)
 - High Point & Reserve High Point Youth (includes all Paint youth classes)
 - High Point & Reserve High Point Open (includes all Paint open classes except futurities & stallion service)
 - High Point & Reserve High Point Solid Bred (includes all Paint solid bred classes – amateur, youth & open)
 - Versatility (includes hunter under saddle, western pleasure, reining & barrels – Paint open classes)
24. GMEC division champions will be calculated as follows (combined from Saturday and Sunday classes):
- High Point Junior Western (**Sat:** 47, 78, 91, 101, 110 / **Sun:** 48, 78, 90, 101, 110)
- High Point Senior Western (**Sat:** 50, 79, 97, 107, 113 / **Sun:** 51, 79, 96, 107, 113)
- High Point Junior English (**Sat:** 60, 69, 76, 78 / **Sun:** 60, 69, 76, 78)
- High Point Senior English (**Sat:** 66, 72, 77, 79 / **Sun:** 66, 72, 77, 79)
- High Point Junior Gymkhana (**Sat:** 130, 138 / **Sun:** 129, 137)
- High Point Senior Gymkhana (**Sat:** 135, 143 / **Sun:** 134, 142)

PLP Facility Rules

The following rules are approved by the Board of Directors of Princess Louise Park Show Centre Inc. to ensure the safety and well being of participants, spectators, staff and animals utilizing the facility and will be strictly enforced. Non-compliance or breach of any of these rules could result in penalties to the Show Committee/Organization.

1. **Absolutely No Smoking** inside any building or the arena.
2. No electrical appliances are to be used inside any barn (except those used exclusively for animal grooming)
3. Only PLP staff and designated trades people are permitted to use, adjust or operate PLP equipment, tractor, tools, lights and cleaning utensils.
4. Pets must be on a leash.
5. All nails, hooks, staples, posters and signs must be removed from stalls and walls before departure.
6. Outside utility connections (water and electrical) are to be used only for trailer hook ups
7. Aisles are to be kept clean and free of obstacles (tack, equipment, hay)
8. Manure, garbage and recyclables to be placed in appropriate container/location. **NO MIXING GARBAGE – WE RECYCLE.**

All complaints and requests are to be made to your Show Committee who in turn will communicate with PLP on site management and staff. PLP Staff are not permitted to make changes without management approval.

Information for all users of Princess Louise Park Show Centre

1. PLP Show Centre facility includes only the barns and indoor show ring arena.
2. Outside practice area and Cattle Penning ring may be available for warm up but are “USE at OWN RISK”.
3. Electrical service is 15 amp only.
4. Show ring and practice areas must be vacated before any grooming will take place.

MARTIME PAINT HORSE CLUB FUTURITY RULES

1. The following futurities will be offered by the Maritime Paint Horse Club in 2009:
 - a. Weanling Halter Futurity
 - B. Yearling Futurity (combined Halter, Longe Line & In Hand Trail) {NOTE: must compete in all 3 to qualify}
 - c. 2 Year Old Longe Line Futurity
 - d. Hunter Under Saddle Futurity
 - e. Trail Futurity
 - f. Western Pleasure Futurity
2. All horses except unregistered weanlings must have a numbered APHA regular or solid-bred registration certificate. A photocopy of the registration certificate must accompany the futurity entry form (except for weanlings – in which case only the entry form is required).
3. Entry fee is \$50.00 per futurity and is due by **August 24, 2009**. No late entries will be accepted. 15% of all entry fees will be withheld to help defray expenses.
4. Mail all futurity entries to the following address: **Jodi Smith, 1649 Route 112, Upper Coverdale NB, E1J 1X9**
5. All payments are final and each futurity entry must enter their regular respective class (either open, amateur, or youth). For the combined yearling futurity, the exhibitor must enter all three of their regular respective classes (halter, longe line, & in hand trail). 75% of entry fees will be refunded upon presentation of a signed veterinarian's certificate.
6. The horse owner and exhibitor (if different) showing in Maritime Paint Horse Club Futurities **MUST** be current members in good standing with the club.
7. Futurity payouts are as follows: 1st – 38%, 2nd – 22%, 3rd – 15%, 4th – 11%, 5th – 8%, 6th – 6%. Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place in each futurity and each futurity winner will be awarded an embroidered jacket.
8. Futurity results will be calculated over two go-rounds – one on Saturday, September 5th and one on Sunday, September 6th. NOTE: You must compete in all go-rounds to qualify unless a signed veterinarian's certificate can be provided.
9. Placings in the futurity go-rounds will be calculated by converting each judge's placing into numerical scores. These placings will be announced after each go-round. The Futurity Chairperson will calculate the final placings and these will be announced on Sunday. If the overall scores result in a tie, the tie-breaking judge will be used. The tie-breaking judge for this year will be the judge on Sunday, September 6th.
10. Points will be calculated according to the table shown in the Show Rules & Regulations.
11. The Maritime Paint Horse Club reserves the right to cancel these futurities without notice and without liability any time prior to the contest. In this case, all entry monies will be refunded.
